GE Healthcare Part Warranty



1. Part Warranty (excluding "Specialty Components" identified below).

<u>GE Healthcare Brand Parts</u>. Each part will be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use and service, and will perform substantially in accordance with GE Healthcare's written specifications (as they exist on the date the part is shipped). The warranty period is 120 days for new, refurbished and repaired parts, and 90 days for harvested/used parts, and starts on the delivery date of the part.

<u>Non-GE Healthcare Brand Parts</u>. Each part will be free from defects in material under normal use and service. The warranty period is 90 days for new, refurbished and repaired parts, and 30 days for used parts, and starts on the delivery date of the part.

2. Specialty Component Warranty.

<u>GE Healthcare Brand Specialty Components</u>. Each detector, probe, tube or image intensifier will be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use and service, and will perform substantially in accordance with GE Healthcare's written specifications (as they exist on the date the part is shipped). The warranty period starts on the delivery date of the part and is limited in time as identified below.

Non-GE Healthcare Brand Specialty Components. Each detector, probe, tube or image intensifier will be free from defects in material under normal use and service. The warranty period starts on the delivery date of the part and is limited in time as identified below.

Purchaser must pay the then-current price of the Specialty Component replacement less the Pro Rata warranty allowance (a fraction of a month less than 15 days will be disregarded, and a fraction of a month equal to or greater than 15 days will be regarded as a full month).

3. Remedy and Limitation.

If purchaser promptly notifies GE Healthcare of its claim during the warranty, GE Healthcare will (at its option) repair, adjust, or replace (with new or refurbished/repaired replacement parts) the non-conforming part. The foregoing is purchaser's sole and exclusive remedies (and GE Healthcare's sole and exclusive liability) for warranty claims. NO OTHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF NON-INFRINGEMENT, MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, WILL APPLY. The warranty for a part provided to correct a warranty failure is the unexpired term of the warranty for the repaired or replaced part. Warranty does not include installation. GE Healthcare has no obligation to purchaser for warranty claims if purchaser uses the part: (i) for non-medical or entertainment use or outside the United States; (ii) in combination with any software, hardware, or services not recommended in writing by GE Healthcare; and (iii) in a manner or environment for which GE Healthcare did not design or license it, or in violation of GE Healthcare's recommendations or instructions. In addition, the warranty does not cover: (a) a defect or deficiency from improper storage or handling, improper maintenance or use, inadequate back-up or virus protection, cyber-attacks, failure to maintain within OEM specifications power quality, grounding, temperature, humidity and repairs due to power anomalies, or any cause external to the part or beyond GE Healthcare's control; (b) payment or reimbursement of facility costs arising from repair or

replacement of the part; (c) adjustment, alignment, calibration, or planned maintenance; (d) lost or stolen parts; (e) parts with serial numbers altered, defaced or removed; (f) modification of the part not approved in writing by GE Healthcare; (g) purchaser designs, specification or instructions; and (h) with regard to ultrasound Specialty Components, damage caused by any use that does not conform to OEM guidelines (e.g., accidental damage, improper cleaning, disinfecting, immersed in liquid, TEE bite marks). If an exchange part is provided, the original becomes GE Healthcare property and purchaser must return it to GE Healthcare within a reasonable timeframe of replacement to avoid being billed for the non-returned part.
